- ❖ Light green to chartreuse leaves
- ❖ Lavender flowers on 48" scapes
- ❖ Blooms in mid to late summer
- ❖ Huge, sun tolerant hosta

Adaptable to a wide range of conditions, but grows best in moist, well-drained, organic soil with an acidic to neutral pH.

Astilbe, Lungwort
(*Pulmonaria*), Snakeroot-
Black (*Cimicifuga*), Bleeding
Heart (*Dicentra*), Brunnera,
Foamflower (*Tiarella*), Coral
Bells (*Heuchera*), Corydalis
